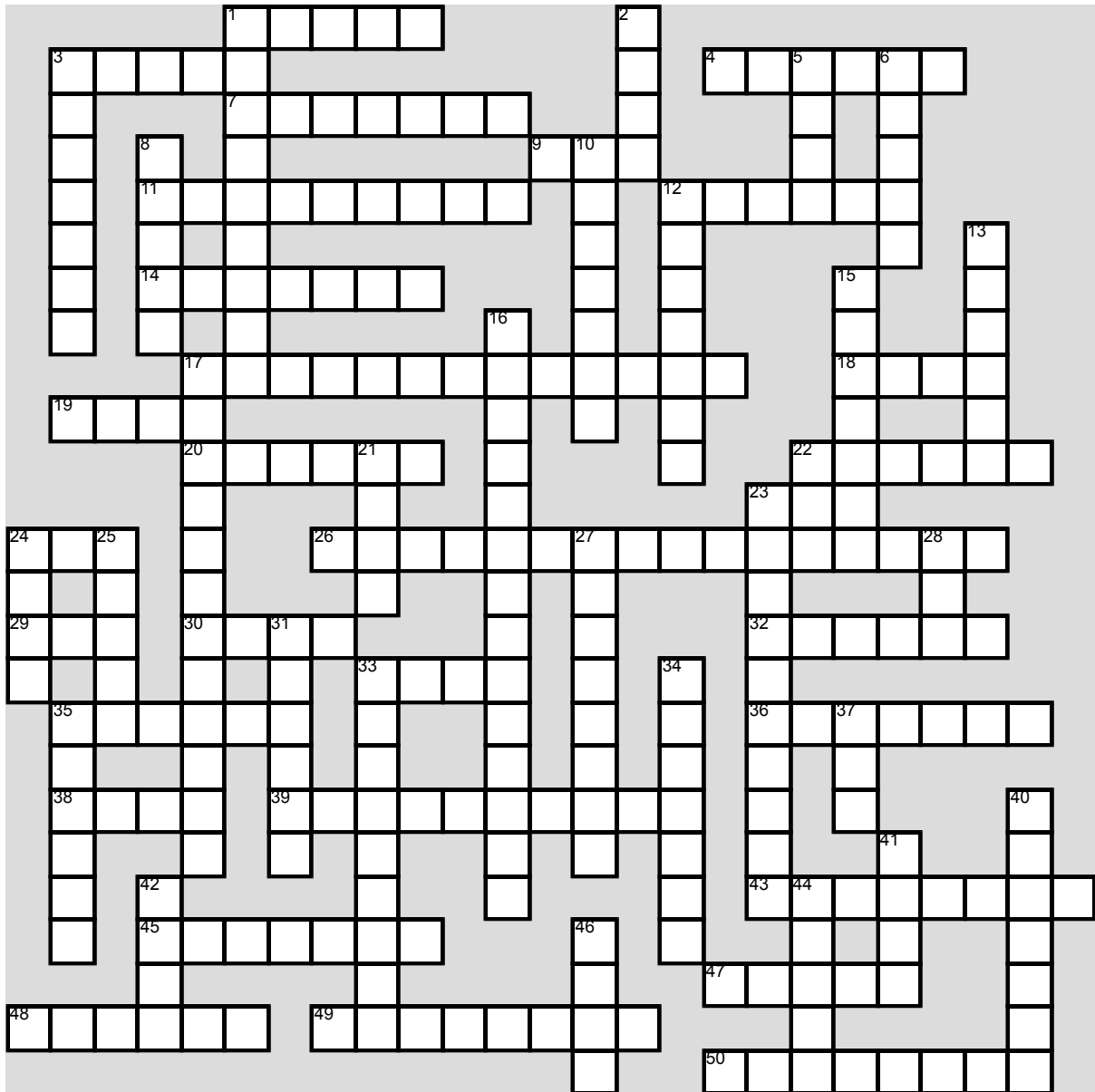


Camden Conference Puzzler
